Review done: an article that I have personally read and reviewed (not taking into account reviews that I have delegated to sub-reviewers). Journal’s reviews are counted once (even when there are multiple iterations). Articles that I reviewed multiple times for different venues are counted multiple times.

Review generated: for each submission, this is the number of reviews obtained for the submission¹ divided by the number of co-authors on the article.

¹Usually 3, but sometimes 4 or 5.
